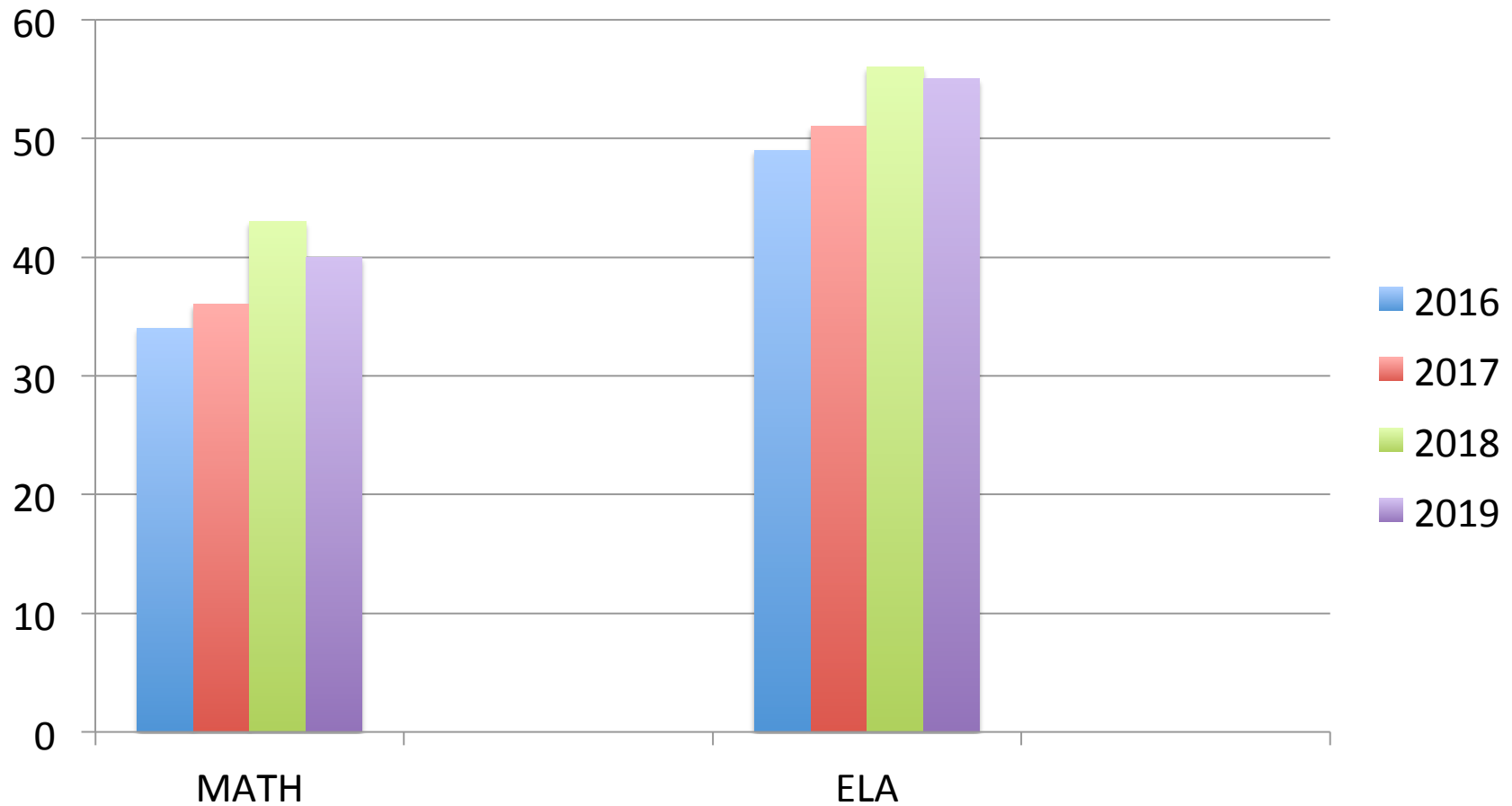

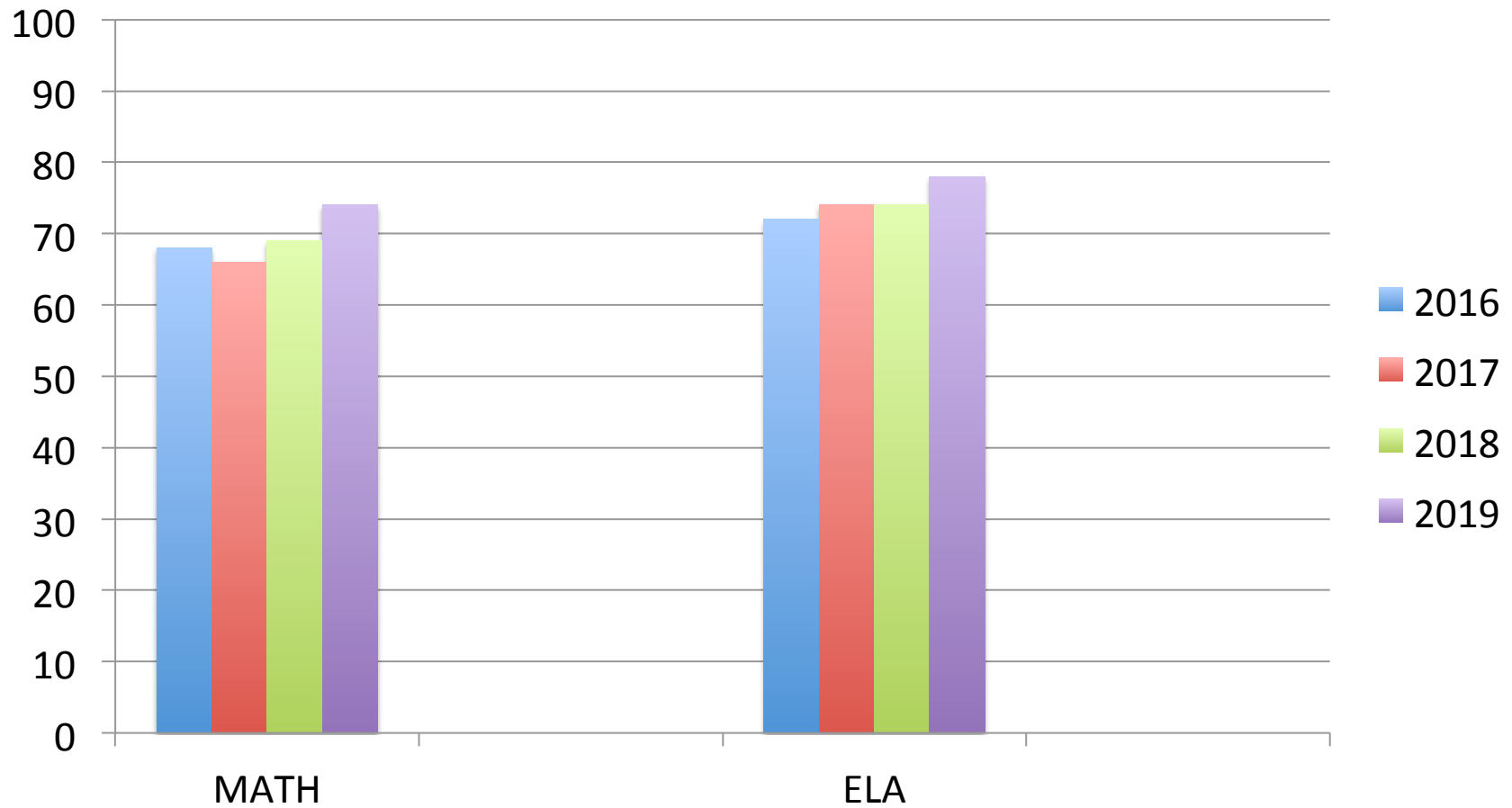


# Pilot Years Comparison
