

Good afternoon,

Appreciate your continued support and advocacy of our school community, our families, and staff during this rapidly changing time, where all adapt and move in response to the Coronavirus pandemic.

A few updates as they have been shared with me:

1. Just announced this morning by LAUSD Superintendent Beutner, effective Monday, March 16, all District schools will be closed for two weeks.
2. iPads are to be sent home today to help support continuity of learning at home. They **MUST BE RETURNED** to the school once we are allowed to resume school, as they are LAUSD property. Scholars will be able to access the same online learning tools that they access at school. Teachers are also sharing with families via their online communication tools (Class Dojo, SeeSaw, etc.) as well as through paper packets, additional activities/tasks that connect to trimester three unit studies to keep scholars engaged. Additional websites such as PBS Learning Media: <https://ca.pbslearningmedia.org/> and Khan Academy: www.khanacademy.org are additional examples of online tools that scholars can access.
3. Local television is another resource to support continuity of learning with schools closed → KCET will offer programming for high school, KLCS will offer content for grades 3-8 while PBS SoCal KOCE will offer programming for grades PREK-2.
4. LAUSD is finalizing plans to still continue feeding our scholars through Family Resource Centers...stay tuned for updates there.
5. Via this platform as well as via school texts, I'll keep you informed as news and updates come my way. Please keep your eye on the news as well as lausd.net for updates. LAUSD has also set up a hotline for families: (213) 443-1300.

At present, there are still no known cases within LAUSD schools. All of the above actions are being taken as safety/precautionary measures to prevent further spread of COVID-19.
