This was our 5th year of providing meals along with our Science, Technology, Engineering, and Mathematics (STEM) enrichment program (pictured above).

It's critical that BBCDC remains a local resource here in the Baldwin Village/Crenshaw community where over 84% of the student population that attends school district (LAUSD) receive free or reduced meals vs. 74% in Los Angeles – countywide.

Through our Thankful Thursdays *Fall* Campaign, we will continue to deliver a variation of our summer program by providing a week's supply of meals (breakfast, lunch and dinner), household products, and STEM activities, lessons, resources & backpacks to kids in grades K-12.
