Overview

Overview: The Program Selection Form is an online survey that will be distributed to all Los Angeles Unified families to collect information on their choice for the instructional model they would like for their child(ren) to participate in when students are able to physically return to campus. As a “selection form,” the choice a family makes on this form will be binding until we hear otherwise, and will inform programming at the school level. Safety Measures

SAFETY PROTOCOLS

THE THREE S'S

The following health and safety protocols will be in place at every school and office.

Every day starts with a commitment to safety and Three S's: Screening, Sanitizing, and Social Distancing. It is up to everyone to use the **Three S's** to protect their health and the health of others.



SCREENING OF STUDENTS AND EMPLOYEES

A check-in area for health screening questions will be in place with enough space to maintain privacy. Daily upon arrival at the site, employees and students check in for health screening.



MODIFIED CLASSROOM LAYOUTS

Classrooms have been reconfigured to ensure safe social distancing is always taking place.



FACE MASKS

Face masks will be required and offered to all students, employees, and visitors while on campus.

Three S for Site Safety



Start every day with Screening
If you have a fever, cough, or flu-like symptoms, please **DO NOT** enter. Return when you're well.



Sanitize frequently

- Practice rigorous hand hygiene.
- Clean high-touch surfaces frequently.
- Wear a face covering - age 2 and over.



Practice Social Distancing

- Keep at least 6 feet between people at all times.
- Look to signs that mark 6 feet of distance on the floor or wall.
- Distribution of food, devices and other items must comply with social distancing requirements.



Keeping safe and healthy is everyone's job!

Safety Measures



PHYSICAL DISTANCING

Signage and floor markings will be used to help remind about social distancing, which will be key to nearly every aspect of returning to school - during class, breaks, and lunch periods, too.



HYGIENE

Restrooms and handwashing sinks in classrooms will be stocked with soap and paper towels. Hand sanitizer will also be available in locations throughout campus.



DISINFECTING CLASSROOM FURNITURE AND OTHER SURFACES

Facilities are being kept clean and sanitized daily with an electrostatic mister.



UPGRADED AIR-FILTRATION SYSTEMS

Heating, Ventilation and Air Conditioning systems have been modified to maximize the circulation of outside air, ventilate 24/7 and are being upgraded with higher performing MERV-13 filters whenever possible.

Instructional Models

INSTRUCTIONAL MODELS

The two models for instruction that will be available for families to select for their students will be the Hybrid Model and Online Only. Please keep in mind that the models described here are based on the latest health and science information and may be subject to change.

Hybrid Model - In this model, students participate in a mix of on-campus, in-person instruction and online learning.

At all grade levels, students remain in consistent cohorts, meaning they stay with the same students each day. The times when students will be on campus will vary by grade.

Online Only - In this model, students will continue to learn exclusively online, similar to how we began the 2020-2021 school year.



Instructional Models

Elementary

Hybrid Learning

- Students return to campus for in-person instruction for a portion of the week with fewer students on campus at any given time
- While on campus, students will remain in a consistent cohort
- Students complete coursework online when not receiving direct, in-person instruction
- Extended supervision options will be available on campus for students when not receiving in-person instruction
- Meals provided daily
- Can opt into Online Only learning model at any time

Online Only Learning

- Students participate in all learning online, with a mix of live instruction with a teacher and independent work time
- Meals available on campus through Grab & Go
- Can opt into Hybrid Learning Model at designated points in the school calendar, as space is available
- Based on enrollment, students might attend “Virtual Academy” with a teacher from their school, or another school

Deadline & ID

Sunday, Dec 6	Deadline to submit the Program Selection Form online
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ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

- Student ID is “required” to complete the form
 - If a parent does not have their Student ID, they can still complete using name, gender, and date of birth, but Student ID is highly encouraged
- A separate form should be completed for every child in a household attending an LAUSD school
- After the deadline, if no response is collected for a student, they will be placed into the Hybrid Model by default
